CALLING AND HISTORY

Our calling resides in: **Haggai 2:8** "all the gold and silver are Mine, says the Lord...get to work
Proverbs 24:11 "Rescue those being led away to death..."; **Proverbs 31:8-9** ..."speak up for those who have no voice..."; **Deuteronomy 30:19** ..."choose life so that you and your children may live..."

- 1995 God called a few people to establish a pregnancy center in Loganville, GA, Walton County
- 1997 A Center of Hope CPC, Inc. began offering free pregnancy tests to Walton County residents
- 2004 Due to lack of volunteers and funds the ministry was failing and faced possible closing
- 2005 God ordained a community meeting at Summit Baptist Church that brought 15+ volunteers
- 2006 New name – PRCW open in new location provided by God through Summit Baptist Church
- 2007-10 Added 2 paid staff part-time positions, 2 volunteer Board Members and E.W.Y.L. program
- 2011 Pursuing God's vision of conversion to medical clinic to offer free ultrasound to women with unplanned pregnancies to answer the questions of a viable pregnancy and the baby's age, and to promote the choice of LIFE... **90% choose life after ultrasound**
- 2011-Fall NURSE MANAGER MIRIAM NELSON HIRED AND TRAINED TO PERFORM ULTRASOUND
- 2012 Staff training to facilitate trainers for Walton Co. schools to teach "sexual health" and "fetal development"

MINISTRY MODEL

PRCW is a private non-profit organization and a Christian ministry dedicated to the caring, teaching, and healing mission of Jesus Christ. PRCW's compassion is based on a personal relationship with God through Christ as revealed in the Word of God. PRCW's scope of information is limited to **FACTS** about fetal development, abortion procedures and abortifacients, consultation of options and alternatives to abortion, healthy pregnancy and birth, and the truth of God's Word. PRCW's support consists of resources such as free pregnancy testing, maternity clothes and baby items earned with dignity and responsibility through the Earn While You Learn program, referrals for community support services, referrals for health care, referrals for adoption services, abstinence counseling, compassionate and non-judgmental care, including post-abortion recovery support through Bible study one to one as well as group support meetings, according to the communities' and churches' requests.

All services are provided FREE and with strict confidentiality.

Over 1500 client visits, 36+ lives changed for eternity through Christ, 35+ babies born!
Women and their families are receiving parenting education, material aid and Bible study.
Over 6000 hours have been served at the PRCW by volunteers!

PRCW MEDICAL CLINIC IS OPEN IN MONROE, at 700-B Breedlove Drive, offering **free ultrasound** to qualified clients (7 weeks pregnant). PRCW is training facilitators to educate students on "Sexual Health" and "Fetal Development" with a State Board of Education approved course.
